

Holster Safety - This is required, not an option.

A lot of shooting ranges across the country have started to ban holsters because of Negligent Discharge. We encourage everyone to take weapons training. If you haven't yet, we hope these simple guidelines will keep you safe until then.



#1 Before playing with live ammo, please remember these simple rules and "Keep your finger off the trigger at all times."



#2 Since we always treat every gun like it is loaded, never point it at anything you do not wish to destroy and keep your finger off the trigger.



#3 When holstering your weapon, "LOOK" and be sure there isn't anything in your holster and keep your finger off the trigger.



#4 Once you have verified that your holster is clear, insert your handgun with your thumb on the back of the slide. This will insure that your weapon does not go out of battery and keep your finger off the trigger."



#5 When drawing your weapon, "ALWAYS" keep your finger straight and off the trigger.
